ECOM Coffee - Papua New Guinea

Due to recent business development opportunities, we are looking to recruit experts for an upcoming technical assistance (TA) project in Papua New Guinea (PNG).

About the project

The Asian Development Bank is procuring a TA team to support the implementation of a loan of up to \$100 million to ECOM Agroindustrial Corp Ltd and its subsidiaries (ECOM). The TA will support smallholder coffee farmers in PNG, in family-based planning and climate-resilient coffee agroforestry. It will also train all PNG-based ECOM staff, extension officers and field buying agents on gender, equity and diversity. Simplified demonstration farms will be developed to showcase climate-resilient replanting and farm management. The TA aims to promote gender equality and women's economic empowerment by strengthening their decision-making roles, and building financial and technical skills.

About the roles

International Gender Specialist: 6 person months

National Gender Specialist: 24 person months

- Prior experience with conducting training programs for smallholder farmers in the farming sector is a must.

- Strong written and spoken fluency in English, and ability to communicate in Tok Pisin or other local languages.

International Senior Coffee Agronomist: 2 person months

- Proven experience in integrating climate change adaptive measures with smallholder farmers, including strong experience with coffee.
