The proposed Smallholder Resilient Economic Development Project (2026-2031) will (i) roll-out inclusive technical services and green investment for nature-positive smallholder agriculture in targeted communes, (ii) rehabilitate or construct small-scale climate resilient infrastructure for improved productivity and better market access, (iii) strengthen the long-term resilience of poorer communities through Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR), climate-risk management for selected cropping systems, insurance and financing; and (iv) promote women’s empowerment in agriculture and food consumption.
